The Food Trust Launches 2023 Farmers Market Season with New Year-Round Market in Northern Liberties

Philadelphia, PA – The Food Trust's Farmers Market Program, which operates a network of year-round and seasonal farmers markets across the city of Philadelphia, is launching the 2023 season with the announcement of a brand-new farmers market: **Northern Liberties Farmers Market**, a partnership with Post Brothers and the Northern Liberties Business Improvement District.

Located in the courtyard of Piazza Alta (1099 Germantown Ave., near the intersection of Second Street and Germantown Avenue), this farmers market will open to the public on **Saturday**, **June 3**, **2023**, **from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.** and will continue every Saturday year-round, featuring over a dozen vendors including fruit and vegetable farmers, dairy purveyors, chocolate makers and local brewers.

Northern Liberties Farmers Market is made possible with generous support from Post Brothers and Penn Treaty Special Services District, as well as The Food Trust's Presenting Sponsor for all 2023 farmers markets, Green Mountain Energy.
